Classroom Spotlight

I am very pleased with our progress. The students are transitioning well to their new school, friends and routine. I have made an adjustment to my behavior management. I have moved to a block management system. Every morning the students start the day with 5 blocks. Goal is to keep as many blocks as you can. Throughout the day a student may lose a block if they aren't making good choices. At the end of the day each student counts their remaining blocks and those are traded in for bucket fillers. Monday was our first day trying this behavior program. They responded well and WANTED to keep all their blocks. I will communicate the number of blocks they have at the end of the day by writing a number in their star for the day, if needed I will write a note as well. 


